

Welcome to the Burlington Humane Society, and thank you for your interest in rescuing a pet! We are excited that you are here.

Please note that we are not open to visitors just to say hi to the animals; our walk-ins are reserved for people who are sincerely interested in adopting. We also do not do walk-ins for dog adoptions, only cats.

Also, please be aware that for the time being, we are still requesting that our visitors be masked. If you are unable to do so, we are more than happy to facilitate zoom meetings with the cats instead of in person.

When you come to the shelter as a walk-in, here is what to expect:

- 1. Please have the adoption application filled out in advance! If you haven't done it yet, it can be done any time from any device. Here is the link: https://www.shelterluv.com/matchme/adopt/BHUM/Cat
- 2. We only have very limited staff and volunteers, and walk-ins are first come, first served. Each walk-in appointment can take upwards of an hour, so be patient with us.
- 3. You are not guaranteed a cat by coming to the shelter.
- 4. Every member of the household must be present.
- 5. Before you meet any cats, you will have an interview with our Adoption Counsellor. If this is successful, you will then get to meet and spend time with the cats to figure out which might be the best fit for your family!
- 6. Please bring a carrier; if you find your new furever friend, you will be able to take them home with you that day!
