After x-rays were taken, the veterinarian was shocked at the severity of the fracture. Her leg was broken in two different places. She must have suffered a huge impact in order to cause such an injury. After suffering through surgery, which involved re-positioning the leg and securing it with a plate held in place with several screws, she came through with flying colours.

As she recovered, Primrose surprised us this month by giving birth to 5 kittens. We didn't even realized she was expecting!



She is the best Mom. Primrose and her kittens are now being taken care of by a local veterinarian. We know she and her kittens are in good hands.

Ban on Animal Cosmetic Testing

On March 28, the Government of Canada tabled the 2023 Budget Bill with long awaited provisions to ban cosmetic testing on animals. This is a huge win for animal welfare! Cosmetic testing is not only unnecessary and painful for animals, but it's an issue that Humane Canada has been advocating to end for a long time. Humane Canada consulted with the Government on the development of the provisions and is proud to see Canada join the ranks of over 40 countries that have already enacted laws that ban or limit cosmetic animal testing.



Pet Safety Stickers

Pet safety matters to Burlington Humane. We have partnered with Burlington Fire Department and have pet safety stickers avaliable. Let Burlington Fire Department know what animals are in your home by placing a "Pets Inside" sticker on your front door.


